Release of Liability and Information

We, the undersigned parents of _____ (hereinafter "student(s)") at Buffalo Creek Boys School (hereinafter BCBS) fully understand, acknowledge and accept that:

- 1) Education at BCBS will be rigorous, both physically and scholastically;
- 2) Activities at BCBS involve responsible risks, including outdoor activities, hand and power tools, cutting instruments (knives, chisels, axes, scalpels, etc.), mountaineering (ropes, belay devices, harnesses), swimming kayaking, canoeing, hiking, camping, animal (equine, bovine and wild) and other adventurous and inherently dangerous activities, as well as automobile travel to, from and during school activities;
- 3) BCBS and its staff will take reasonable precautions, provide instruction and rules for each activity, as well as reasonable supervision;
- 4) Boys will have free time and cannot be directly supervised at all times;
- 5) All risk of injury and/or death cannot be eliminated and adherence to all rules by students cannot be assured.

Therefore, in exchange for the opportunity of the participation of student (s) in the educational opportunities at BCBS, we hereby agree to release BCBS, its employees, staff, volunteers, landowners on which BCBS activities occur and other students from all claims of liability and agree to fully indemnify them against all claims, including costs, attorney fees and all other amounts alleged for damages arising from any injury or incident involving students(s), and to hold all of the above named harmless from all such claims of liability.

Further, we agree, consent and authorize BCBS to do the following:

- 1) Seek and consent to emergency medical treatment for students(s);
- 2) Transport and allow volunteers to transport student(s) to, from and during school activities;
- 3) Photograph and publish photographs of student(s) without additional permissions;
- 4) Exercise disciplinary authority with students to include withholding of privileges, activities, snacks/food, assignments of work/physical labor tasks; and
- 5) Administer aspirin, Tylenol or ibuprofen as recommended by manufacturer.

I have carefully read this document and acknowledge that I am agreeing not to hold BCBS, its employees, volunteers, staff, landowners on which school activities occur responsible for any injury to my student(s) which may arise in school related activities.
